TRNAVA DAYS OF LAW

THE 70th ANNIVERSARY OF THE CIVIL CODE OF 1950 AND LEGAL POLITICS IN THE 20th CENTURY

In the mid-20th century Czechoslovakia, legal or law-making politics was particularly close to general politics – and it did not conceal this fact at all. The first civil code in the history of Slovakia, as the code representing a new paradigm of law in the Communist Party's views, was a proof of this. The ideological and political background of the legislation of the People's Democratic and later Socialist regime was clear and deliberate, as opposed to the allegedly hidden political and "partisan" nature of bourgeois regulations. However, legal politics does not only materialize at this prima facie "political and ideological" level. The whole process of law-making, from identifying and selecting regulatory objectives, through the choice of regulatory means, to the choice of ways to enforce the selected legal solutions, represents a wide range of issues that the legal scholarship does not pay much attention to. The conference section of the Department of History of Law, in an effort to examine this topic in greater detail, therefore aims to focus on all of the outlined - broadly understood - theoretical and practical aspects of legal politics, with an emphasis on the 20th century and on Czechoslovakia. However, comparative contributions setting the topic into a broader timeframe and geographical framework are also very much welcome.
